

ATX 2013 sees win streak conclude

The Pflugerville-based, ATX 2013 basketball team is enjoying another successful season, compiling a current win/loss record of 30-7 which included a 19-game win streak.

The AAU team is comprised of recently graduated 8th graders, the majority of which reside in Pflugerville.

This is the fourth year of the teams' existence with current players being: Jalen Campbell and Andrew Hill of Dessau Middle School, Jay Byrd and Aaron McDaniel of Pflugerville Middle School and Isaak Gonzales, Josh King, and Ryan Lamb of Kelly Lane.
