Question to board: Why is DB Wood noisier?

Answer from City: "The method used on DB Woods Road was called a chip seal which is used to protect the pavement from deteriorating effects of the sun and weather. A secondary benefit of a chip and seal is to increase the skid resistance of the pavement surface. This is done by spraying an application of asphalt, immediately covered by a single layer of uniformed size aggregate. This should help the road stay in good shape for about another 2-5- years."

Question to board: What is "Hot In Place" recycling process which will be used on Ridgecrest and adjacent streets when you start this project; and, the necessary steps to be taken which will affect overhanging trees.

Answer from City: "a contract or will be used to come in and cut the tree limbs that will be effected. Anything which is lower than 13'

3..The treatment that will be used in your area is call HOT-IN-PLACE RECYCLING. It is a three part treatment that consists of A. Surface recycling or heater scarification -Where the surface is heated,loosen,modified,remixed and re-laid as new wear surface.

B. Remixing- Process where new HOT MIX ASPHALT (HMA) is

combined directly with the recycled mixture to improve the recycling mixture before it is paved.

C. REPAVING-process where the recycling surface is overlaid immediately with a new HMA mixture to form a thermal bond between the newly mixture and new HMA wearing surface."
