**CAMP PHILOSOPHY:**

A high school camp run by high school officials for high school referees. Only high school rules using 2 and 3 man mechanics will be taught. Our goal is to make you a better high school official.

**WHY THIS CAMP:**

The only camp geared to people wanting to become or improve as high school referees, and at a high school price. Before you can become a college official, you must become a very good high school official.

**OBSERVATIONS:**

Campers are rated by several evaluators each time they take the court. You will be seen by each counselor in attendance; thus receiving critiques of your ability by many sources. I personally observe each camper and offer my advice and observations.

**CHAMPIONSHIP GAME:**

The staff will discuss and evaluate every camper in a private meeting with the Director and the top 3 campers will referee the Championship Game.

**HOUSING:**

Campers will stay in air-conditioned dorms on campus.

**MEALS:**

Breakfast, lunch and dinner are served in the air-conditioned cafeteria near the dorms.

**FACILITIES:**

The main gym at UNC-Wilmington will be used for the games. A classroom will be used for the meetings and film evaluations.

**BRING:**

Each camper should bring pillows, linen, personal items plus referee shoes, gray referee shirts, black shorts and whistle.

**PHYSICAL EXAM:**

Each camper will be required to sign a statement indicating that he/she has had a physical by a doctor within the past 12 months. Trainers will be on duty at this camp.

**CRITIQUES:**

Counselors will critique on the spot. Campers will know immediately what they need to improve on. No Cassette Recorders are used at this camp. We believe that you learn more by instant feedback; not back in the room 2 hours later.

**VIDEO:**

Faye Mattocks and Sandy Edwards will film each camper one or more times and you will be able to view the results in the company of a counselor. Tapes will be re-used unless a camper wishes to purchase or replace the tape.

**COST:**

The cost is \$ 350.00 per camper which includes meals, lodging, tuition, and a TMRC tee shirt. Day Campers cost is \$ 300.00, but is discouraged. You learn valuable lessons in the dorms.

**DEPOSIT:**

A deposit of \$ 150.00 to hold your place is due by May 1, 2012. The deposit is non-refundable after June 1, 2012.
