CLINIC PHILOSOPHY:

A high school clinic run by high school officials for high school referees. Only high school rules using 2 and 3 man mechanics will be taught. Our goal is to make you a better high school official.

WHY THIS CLINIC:

The only clinic geared to people wanting to become or improve as high school referees, and at a high school price. Before you can become a college official, you must become a very good high school official.



OBSERVATIONS:

Officials are rated by several evaluators each time they take the court. You will be seen by each counselor in attendance; thus receiving critiques of your ability by many sources. I personally observe each official and offer my advice and observations.

CHAMPIONSHIP GAME:

The staff will discuss and evaluate every official in a private meeting with the Director and the top 3 campers will referee the Championship Game.

HOUSING:

PHYSICAL EXAM:

Each official will be required to sign a statement indicating that he/she has had a physical by a doctor within the past 12 months. Trainers will be on duty at this clinic.

CRITIQUES:

Counselors will critique on the spot. Officials will know immediately what they need to improve on. No Cassette Recorders are used at this clinic. We believe that you learn more by instant feedback; not back in the room 2 hours later.

VIDEO:

Faye Mattocks and Sandy Edwards will film each Full time official one or more times and you will be able to view the results in the company of a counselor. Tapes will be re-used unless an official wishes to purchase or replace the tape.

COST:

The cost is \$ 300.00 per full time official which includes meals, lodging, tuition, and a TMRC tee shirt. Part Time Officials cost varies with amount of time you work, see our email chart.. Full time is recommended. You learn valuable lessons in the dorms.

DEPOSIT:

A deposit of \$ 150.00 to hold your place is due by May 1, 2014. The deposit is non-refundable after June 1, 2014. If you choose a price option that is less than \$ 150, your balance is due May 1.
