NIMITZ — Creed T. Bragg, 88, died Thursday, Jan. 12, at 7 a.m. at his home following a long illness.

Born May 30, 1900, in Summers County, he was the son of the late Jackson and Rodha Cox Bragg.

Mr. Bragg had lived most of his life in Summers County, was a retired coal miner and member of the Ellison Missionary Baptist Church.


He was preceded in death by his wife, Martha Ann Baker Bragg on July 12, 1977; a son, Harley Bragg on Dec. 10, 1987 and a daughter, Ruby Jean Bragg on June 24, 1988.
