NIMITZ — Earnest Lee (Ernie) Moyer, 64, died Thursday, Jan. 12, at 12:30 p.m. at Beckley hospital following a long illness.

Born Feb. 2, 1924, at Ellison, he was the son of the late Obie and Berthie Okes Moyer.

Mr. Moyer was a lifetime resident of Nimitz, owner and operator of Ernie Moyer's Garage, decorated Army veteran of World War II, Asiatic Pacific Theater and was a recipient of three Bronze Service Stars and a Bronze Arrow Head. For the Philippine Liberation he received a Bronze Star, Good Conduct Metal, World War II Victory Metal and Meritorious Unit Award. He was of the Christian faith.

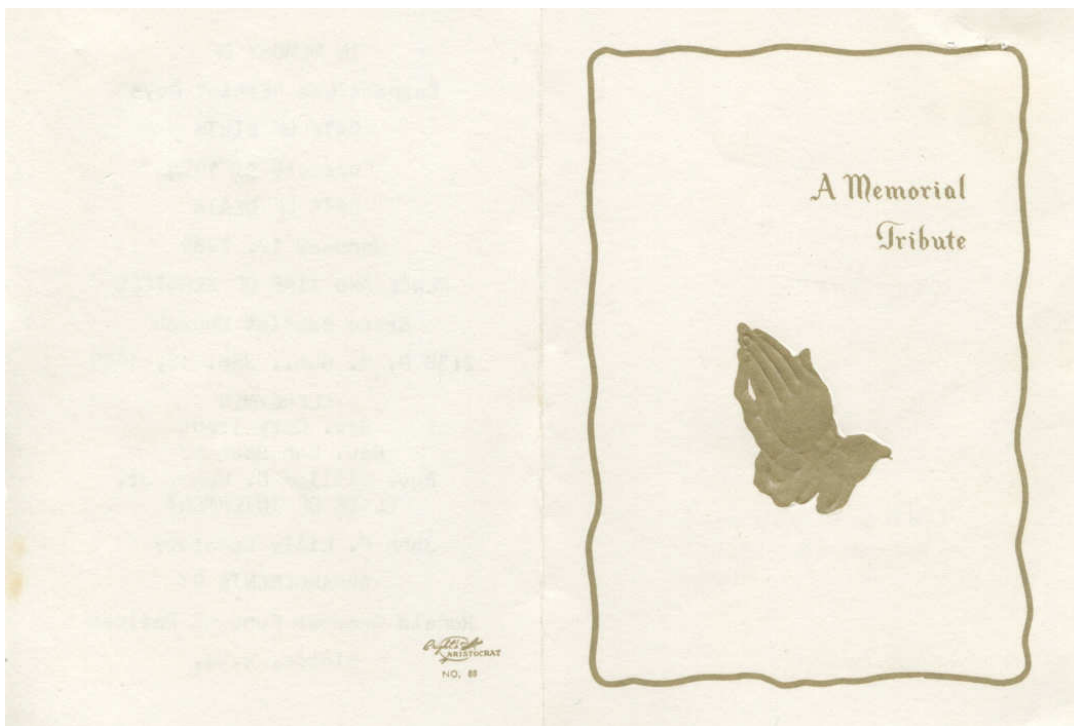
He was preceded in death by a daughter, Patricia Lou Moyer Gantt.
