Eugene E. Chappo, 53, of 127 High St., Beckley, was dead on arrival Wednesday, June 1, 1994 at a Beckley hospital following a short illness.

Born Sept. 2, 1940, at Beckley, he was the son of Steve Chappo of Beckley and the late Mary Seaman Chappo.

Mr. Chappo was of the Christian faith, had served in the US Army during the Korean Conflict where he served as a Military Policeman in the K-9 Corp.

He was the owner and operator of the Bonnie-Blue Ice Cream Company in Beckley, was a former policeman for the City of Beckley, a former policeman for the Austin City Police Department and the Park Rangers in Austin, Texas.
