

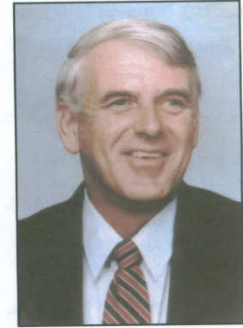
MR. JAMES R. "JIM" FARLEY, SR.
