Jeffrey Lyn Scott, 19, of Crab Orchard was dead on arrival Friday at a Beckley hospital, victim of an apparent suicide, according to the Raleigh County Sheriff's Department.

Born May 6, 1966, in Beckley, he was the son of Leroy and Norma Dickson Scott of Crab Orchard.

Mr. Scott was an employee of the Shields Inc. in Winston Salem, N.C., a member of the Hilltop Baptist Church in Crab Orchard, and was active in Babe Ruth and Little League baseball.

Other survivors include a maternal grandfather, John Dixon of Crab Orchard; three brothers, Jerry Lee Scott of Crab Orchard, Gary Wayne Scott of Stanaford, and Ronald E. Scott of Port St. John, Fla.

Services will be Monday at 2 p.m. at the Hilltop Baptist Church in Crab Orchard with the Revs. Lewis Batchlor and Lyell Zickafoose officiating. Entombment will be in the Blue Ridge Memorial Gardens Mausoleum at Prosperity.
