NIMITZ — Vinson Ray Bragg, 68, died Tuesday, Aug. 5, 1997, in a Charlotte, N.C., hospital following a long illness.

Born Aug. 22, 1928, in Summers County, he was the son of the late Creed T. and Martha A. Baker Bragg.

Mr. Bragg had lived most of his life in Summers and Raleigh counties and attended the Little Country Church at Cool Ridge.

He was an Air Force veteran, a member of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Local 70 of Washington, D.C. and member of the Teamsters Union, where he retired as a truck driver on the Alaska pipeline construction project. He was active in farming as long as health permitted.
