## **CLOTHED IN CHRIST**

Rom 13:12 - The night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us **put on** the armour of light. (All citations KJV)

Memory Text: Rom 13:14 - But **put [you] on** the Lord Jesus Christ, and make not provision for the flesh, to [fulfil] the lusts [thereof].

- - Gal 3:26 For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus.
  - Gal 3:27 For as many of you as <u>have been baptized into Christ</u> have <u>put on</u> Christ.
    - Col 3:1 If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God
      - Col 3:4 When Christ, [who is] our life, shall appear, then shall ye also appear with him in glory.
      - Col 3:8 But now ye also put off all these; anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy communication out of your mouth.
      - Col 3:9 Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have **<u>put off</u>** he old man with his deeds;
      - Col 3:10 And have <u>put on</u> the new [man], <u>which is renewed in knowledge</u> <u>after</u> the image of him that created him:
    - Enh 4:22. That we not off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt
    - Eph 4:22 That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts;
      - Eph 4:23 And be renewed in the spirit of your mind;
      - Eph 4:24 And that ye **put on** the new man, <u>which after God is created in righteousness</u> and true holiness.
- See also: Eph 6:11 <u>Put on</u> the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

  Eph 6: 14 Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and <u>having [put] on</u> the breastplate of righteousness;
  - 1 Cor 15:53 For this corruptible must <u>put on incorruption</u>, and this mortal [must] <u>put on immortality</u>.
    - 1 Cor 15:54 So when this corruptible shall have <u>put on incorruption</u>, and this mortal shall have <u>put on immortality</u>, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, <u>Death is swallowed up in victory</u>.

- 2 Cor 5: 2 For in this we groan, earnestly desiring to be **clothed** upon with our house which is from heaven:
- 2 Cor 5:3 If so be that being **clothed** we shall not be found naked.
- 2 Cor 5:4 For we that are in [this] tabernacle do groan, being burdened: not for that we would be **unclothed**, but **clothed** upon, that mortality might be swallowed up of life.
- 1 Thess 5:8 But let us, who are of the day, be sober, **<u>putting on</u>** the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the hope of salvation.
