SPIRIT BAPTISM

1. Paul's clothing imagery describing the [Spirit] baptismal change in a Christian's nature

- put on Christ (become 'new man'); put off 'old man' -

refers back to Paul's distinction between what it means to be "in Adam" or in Christ"

(YOU CANNOT BE IN BOTH PLACES AT THE SAME TIME!)

in Adam ← CONTRAST → in Christ	
First man Adam, a living soul (1 Cor 15:45a; Gen 2:7) <	> Last Adam, a life-giving spirit [pneuma] (1 Cor 15:45b; KJV: 'quickening spirit')
	a) Gal 3:27 - For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on <i>Christ</i> ;
	b) Rom 13:14 - But put [you] on the Lord Jesus Christ,
and make not provision for the flesh, to [fulfil] the lusts. c) Col 3:9 seeing that ye have put off the old man	
with his deeds;	d) Col 3:10 - And have put on the new [man], which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him:
e) Eph 4:22 - That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts;	
	f) Eph 4:23 - And be renewed in the spirit of your mind; [cf. Philippians 2:5; 1 Cor 2:13-16;]
	g) Eph 4:24 - And that ye put on [endyō] the new man, which after God is created in righteousness true holiness.
