

in Adam <-----> **in Christ**

What does it mean to be in Adam?

– person of the *flesh (sarkos)*. . . (Ephesians 2)

1. "dead in transgressions and sins" (verse 1)

2. walks "according to the ways of this world" . . .

and of the ruler of the kingdom of the air, the spirit who is now at work in those who are disobedient" (v 2)

(e.g. Mark 4:19; Gal 5:19-20; 1 Cor 6:9-10; Col 3:5, 8; 1 Pt 4:3; Eph 4:31; 6:12)

What does it mean to be in Christ?

– But [if] you are not of the flesh ,
– but in the **Spirit (pneuma)** . . .

1. the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made [you] free from the law of sin and death (Rom 8:2)

cf. Rom 3:20; 7:5; Gal 6:8; Col 2:13

For to be carnally [*sark*] minded [is] death; but to be spiritually minded [is] life and peace (Rom 8:6) *cf. Rom 7:14, 25; 8:8; Gal 5:13*

2. no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk NOT after the flesh, but after the Spirit (Rom 8:1)

That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit (Rom 8:4) *cf. Gal 5:16*

For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit (Rom 8:5) *e.g. Gal 5:22; Col 3:12; cf. Ezk 11:19-20*
