# Metallic Cat is 2009 NCHA Horse of Year

Alvin and Becky Fults' great horse Metallic Cat stood up to stiff competition to secure his title as the 2009 NCHA Horse of the Year.

He and Beau Galyean clinched the title at the Derby Open at the South Point Futurity in Las Vegas on Oct. 14, beating Metallic Cat's half-sister, Don't Look Twice, and Phil Rapp.

Metallic Cat and Galyean have earned more than \$625,000 in one season.
