 serve Elizabeth Durbin untill the aforesaid Negroe Wo-
 man do fully compleat Ten Years service with the bond of
 the aforesaid Thomas Watkins, Beaverleth Scott or Elizabeth
 Durbin and then the aforesaid Negroe Maria to be dis-
 charged and clear from all manner of Person whatsoever
 in and to the which Payment well and truly to be made
 and done I bind me my heirs Executors and Administrators
 with the Sum of thirty Pounds of the like current Money
 to be paid in Goods and Chattels with the which whercof I
 have hereunto set my hand and Seal this twelfth day of May 1707
