

Subway robber still at large

The man who robbed a local restaurant at gunpoint Monday morning remains at large today.

The Ruston Police Department is seeking information about the armed robbery that

happened around 9:30 a.m. Monday at the Subway Restaurant on Cooktown Road.

Ruston Police Public Information Officer Lt. Curtis Hawkins said a man wearing dark clothing entered the Subway restaurant, produced a handgun and demanded money.

The suspect then forced

all of the employees into the cooler in the back of the store. He fled the restaurant with an undetermined amount of cash. His direction of travel is unknown.

The suspect was described as a black male, approximately 5'10" tall wearing dark clothing.

Anyone with information about this crime should call Crime Stoppers at 255-1111. Crime Stoppers will pay up to \$1,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of this suspect or any other felony crime.

"We are thankful that none of the employees or customers

was injured during this crime," Hawkins said. "We hope someone will come forward with information that will assist us in identifying and locating this suspect."

The restaurant is open for regular business hours today, according to a Subway employee.
