

Cape Lookout Cruise

June 14 – 19, 2010

Come for several days, enjoying one of the most spectacular anchorages in our area and one of the best beaches on the East Coast. This is also the time that the Loggerhead turtles are nesting – perhaps you will see them from your boat. This cruise is designed to give you the option to connect directly with the Ocracoke bound cruisers, should you desire to do so.



Suggested Itinerary

Monday, June 14

Depart FH and spend the night at anchor in Cedar Creek, off Adams Creek Marker #9

Or Depart FH and spend the night at one of the Beaufort marinas (make your own reservations)

Tuesday, June 15

Leave Cedar Creek (or Beaufort). Plan to arrive Cape Lookout late afternoon. (Note: Beaufort Inlet slack tide @1206EDT; max ebb tide @1501EDT). Welcoming lite splash.

Wednesday, June 16 – Thursday, June 17

Enjoy the Cape: Exploring, shelling, fishing, swimming. Maybe even an anchor hunt.

Ranger Programs: Lighting the Way (15min) @ 1030, 1330, 1530; Island Explorations (30min) @ 1315

Bonfire on the Beach one evening; Heavy splash on the other evening.

Friday, June 18

Leave Cape Lookout (Note: max flood tide at Beaufort Inlet @ 1201EDT)

Anchor in Town Creek (or use town docks or Town Creek Marina) and explore Beaufort.

Plan on Happy Hour at Back Street Pub. Review options for dining out.

Saturday, June 19

Depart for FH or spend an extra day and join the Ocracoke Cruisers on Sunday night at Lower Broad Creek.

Don't forget your beach umbrella, sunblock, and bug spray!!
