

Ferndale Elementary School

The minutes of the October meeting were reviewed. Paul Meyers moved and Patrick Sparks seconded to approve the minutes. Motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: Paul Meyers gave the Treasurer's Report. The balance before candle and t-shirt profits is \$7,499.84. (\$206.20 is from EScrip) A total of 260 candles were sold, making a little more than \$1,000.00. The new logo for the t-shirts was very successful.

Old Business:

*Roster- A current list was provided to those in attendance.

New Business:

*Parent Club Logo- everyone is encouraged to design a logo for Parent Club, and then we can decide which one we like.

*Recycling- Patrick reported that he talked to the person in charge of the recycling program at Arcata Community Recycling, and we can sign up for the program, but they are discontinuing it soon. Eel River Disposal does have a program, and Paul moved and Laurie seconded to sign up for the ERD program. Motion passed. Patrick will take care of the sign ups.

*Books for the Library- Heather Boynton and Leanne McCulloch have submitted a request for science oriented books for the library. After viewing some examples of the books, Laurie moved and Patrick seconded to have Parent Club purchase the books they picked out for \$503.34. Motion passed.

*Heather Boynton asked for financial assistance with her animals in her classroom. Many students benefit from the animals. Patrick moved and Laurie seconded to approve her request for \$263.00. Motion passed.

Other

*Mural- The mural by Shawn Griggs and the Daymakers group is not holding up well. The paint is starting to peel. They would like to mount it in the cafeteria instead of outside in the weather. Paul would like permission to go to Valley Lumber and buy what is needed to frame and mount the mural, and bring the bill to Parent Club. Laurie moved to allow Paul to buy the materials needed and have Parent Club reimburse him the cost. Patrick seconded and the motion passed.

*Aerial Predators is scheduled for January 9, 2009 at 8:45am. The cost is \$600.00. We will cut a check at our December meeting so it is ready to go.
