Volleyball Net Request- a net for the Ball Wall was requested, as the one we have will not fit. Instead of a net, a deer guard was suggested, they are durable and more weatherproof than netting. Patrick will look at the project and see what might work best and be most cost effective. Tammy moved and Shelley seconded to approve the project, cost to be determined and reasonable. Motion passed.
