

East Texas Region T.C.B.A. 2013-2014 Season

1. This league will be known as the East Texas region of the T.C.B.A. It will consist of a maximum of 18 teams with districts of at least six teams each. Returning teams will have till June 1st of each year to pay franchise fee for the following year, to be guaranteed a spot. After that the spots will be filled on a first come first served basis till the 18 spots are filled. Any teams that have not paid their sponsor fee before the league meeting in July will not be allowed into the league.
2. Team captains are responsible for full fees being placed in the envelopes each session. There are to be no arrearages in this league. Should any team be in arrears one session the team shall forfeit all points.
3. There will be a \$30.00 charge for all returned checks.
4. The league will use a schedule according to the number of teams in the league till one pass through the league. Then switch to district play, have a position round, then use a schedule for each district according to the number of teams in each district. There will be a position round after each pass through the district and a final position round the very last round.
5. Once the schedule is set and approved 100% written vote of team captains is required to change the schedule.
6. Any make-up games must be made up prior to the next bowling date or forfeit. If there is a position round in the bowling date the team will miss the games must be made up before that date. An emergency will be decided on a case by case basis by the leagues board of directors.
7. The fine for not wearing an approved shirt, according to TCBA Rules, will be \$5.00 per round. The conduct fine will be \$10.00 starting with the first offense.
8. Last month dues must be paid by the start of bowling in February, if not all Games will be forfeited until the dues are paid.
9. Any rules not covered by league rules will be covered in the T.C.B.A. rule book or the USBC rule book.
